SpectraLink Deploys NetLink Wireless Telephones in Bernalillo County Metropolitan Court

Wi-Fi Telephones Keep Court Personnel Connected

Boulder, Colorado – August 9, 2004 — SpectraLink Corporation (Nasdaq: SLNK), an industry pioneer in enterprise wireless communications, today announced that the State of New Mexico Bernalillo County Metropolitan Court (Metro Court) has selected NetLink Wireless Telephones to provide mobile communication within the court facility. The ten-story Metro Court's new mobile voice communications offer the facility's 16 judges and hundreds of daily visiting jurors an unrivaled means of productivity. Additionally, the NetLink Wireless Telephones provide the court with a higher level of security through improved communications.

Metro Court's deployment of 36 Wi-Fi-based NetLink i640 Wireless Telephones fills the mobile communication gap resulting from Metro Court's newly imposed ban of cellular telephone use. Metro Court employees will have the freedom to roam throughout the courthouse with the durable, lightweight NetLink i640 Wireless Telephones, allowing employees to have real-time access to other staff and emergency services. Equipped with push-to-talk capabilities, the NetLink Wireless Telephones will connect with Metro Court's existing Cisco CallManager voice over IP (VoIP) application server, saving the Court the added expense of upgrading its existing telecommunications infrastructure. The court is ensuring expansive Wi-Fi coverage by deploying 65 BeaconPoint access points from Chantry Networks, which installed the court's WLAN.
