Hundreds of Calls Managed At Largest Public Demonstration of Wireless VoIP

*Nearly 2,000 CTIA WIRELESS I.T. & Entertainment Attendees Take Advantage of
Free Wi-Fi Access and Wireless Telephony*

WALTHAM, MA – NOVEMBER 8, 2004 -- The **CTIA WIRELESS I.T. & Entertainment 2004** conference (October 25 – 27, 2004) held in San Francisco was home to the largest public Voice over Wi-Fi (VoFi) deployment to-date. During the course of the show, conference attendees enjoyed free Wi-Fi access and VoIP over wireless courtesy of AirMagnet, Chantry Networks, PowerDsine and SpectraLink. The companies joined forces to create a best-of-breed wireless network from the ground up, including the supporting infrastructure, wireless access points (APs) and handsets. CTIA President and CEO Steve Largent kicked off the deployment during the show's opening keynote address by placing a live VoIP call to Jerry Rice of the Seattle Seahawks.

The consortium of companies installed and supported a dual-network for attendees with data traffic carried on 802.11a/g and voice traffic on 802.11b to ensure seamless connectivity and voice quality:

- **Chantry Networks** provided a centrally managed BeaconWorks™ voice and data network with 55 BeaconPoint™ APs deployed in the Moscone West Convention Center
- **AirMagnet** helped ensure the network's security and performance with five Enterprise SmartEdge sensors installed in the center to monitor the overall health and security of the network
- **SpectraLink** provided handsets and the backend technology to ensure voice quality
- **PowerDsine** offered power over Ethernet technology that reduced the installation time and cost

As a result, attendees were able to stay connected and productive at CTIA WIRELESS I.T. & Entertainment and try VoIP over wireless – in many cases for the first time. In fact:

- The wireless network supported 1,872 unique users at the conference
- Hundreds of voice calls were placed; up to 30 were simultaneous
- The peak usage on a single BeaconPoint was approximately 45 users
- Peak bandwidth utilization reached 5 Mbps (megabits-per-second).

“By offering our attendees firsthand access to innovative technologies, such as wireless telephony and Wi-Fi, we were able to round out their overall experience at CTIA WIRELESS I.T. & Entertainment,” said Rob Mesirow, Vice President, Operations at CTIA. “The deployment offered a glimpse of the potential — including convenience and quality — that wireless holds in store for consumers and businesses, and was well-orchestrated and supported by the participating companies.”
